

# ANIMAL TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS AND REGULATIONS



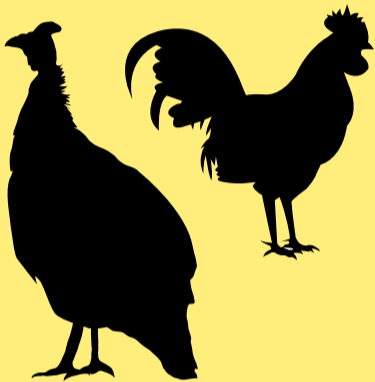
## DOGS

- The dog must be injected for rabies at least 30 days before transportation.
- The dog must be de-wormed at least 30 days before transportation.
- A movement permit must be obtained from the nearest veterinary clinic.



## TRANSPORTATION HOUSING

- The dog should be delivered to Botswana Couriers in a PVC dog carry-cage or metal cage, with a solid base. (No wooden or cardboard cages will be allowed).
- Dogs older than 13 months need to have a muzzle. (Muzzle cap)



## CHICKENS/GUINEA FOWLS

- A movement permit should be obtained from the nearest veterinary clinic for chickens.
- Guinea fowls transportation requires a permit from the Department of Wildlife and Tourism. They must be delivered to Botswana Couriers in closed cages. (No wooden or cardboard cages will be allowed).

### FOOD WHILE IN TRANSIT

- All animals must be fed prior to transportation. Animals may be fed while in transit subject to prior arrangement and approval by Botswana Couriers. Dogs, Chickens and Guinea Fowls to be strictly fed on dry feed in a pellet form.



## GOATS

- Transportation permit. (\*Please note that the movement of goats from the southern parts of Botswana is currently suspended due to the outbreak of Moringa)
- Minimum number of goats to be transported is 10
- Notice of transportation is required 4 days in advance.



## CATTLE

- Movement permit
- Certificate of ownership of cattle (Omang)
- Notice of transportation is required 4 days in advance.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Botswana Couriers does not carry the liability that may be a result of:
  - 1.1 Death in transit where Botswana Couriers, with the acknowledgement of the shipper agree that reasonable measures were taken to avoid such death.
  - 2.2 Damages or harm, (including breakages) in transit.
2. Botswana Couriers is exempted from any liability in incidences of force majeure which may include, but are not limited to road accidents, floods, excessive heat or any other weather conditions.
3. The owner is responsible for any liability of any discoveries of diseases on transported animals and of any diseases that are deemed fatal and the movement of such animals is restricted by the laws of Botswana.
4. Botswana Couriers has the right to decline transportation should they reasonably find the nature of the packaging to be non-compliant to the requirements set forthwith.
5. Feeding of animals prior to transportation remains the shipper's liability.
6. Transportation costs are as per request
7. The shipper agrees that at the time of registering a transportation transaction with Botswana Couriers, agrees with these terms and conditions and shall be bound by the same.
